**CERTIFICATION OF COUNSEL REGARDING ORDER VACATING THE
ORDER GRANTING MOTION OF CHAPTER 11 TRUSTEE TO SHORTEN
NOTICE AND RESPONSE TO TRUSTEE'S MOTION FOR ORDER (I)
AUTHORIZING DEBTORS' ESTATES TO OBTAIN POSTPETITION
FINANCING AND TO GRANT SECURITY INTERESTS AND SUPERPRIORITY
ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSE STATUS PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. §§ 105,
363(c), 364(c), 364(e) AND 507(b); (II) MODIFYING THE AUTOMATIC STAY
PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. § 362; AND (III) GRANTING OTHER RELIEF**

The undersigned hereby certifies as follows:

1. On February 18, 2010, the Chapter 11 Trustee filed the *Motion of Chapter 11 for Order (I) Authorizing Debtors' Estates to Obtain Postpetition Financing and to Grant Security Interests and Superpriority Administrative Expense Status Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 105, 363(c), 364(c), 364(e), and 507(b); (II) Modifying the Automatic Stay Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 362; and (III) Granting Other Relief* (the "Financing Motion") [Docket No. 1051], with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (this "Court").

2. Shortly thereafter, the Chapter 11 Trustee filed the *Motion of Chapter 11 Trustee to Shorten Notice and Response to Trustee's Motion for Order (I) Authorizing Debtors' Estates to Obtain Postpetition Financing and to Grant Security Interests and Superpriority Administrative Expense Status Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 105, 363(c), 364(c), 364(e), and 507(b);*

(II) *Modifying the Automatic Stay Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 362; and (III) Granting Other Relief* (the “Motion to Shorten Notice”) [Docket No. 1052], with this Court.

3. On the same day, this Court entered its *Order Granting Motion of Chapter 11 Trustee to Shorten Notice and Response to Trustee’s Motion for Order (I) Authorizing Debtors’ Estates to Obtain Postpetition Financing and to Grant Security Interests and Superpriority Administrative Expense Status Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 105, 363(c), 364(c), 364(e), and 507(b); (II) Modifying the Automatic Stay Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 362; and (III) Granting Other Relief* (the “Order to Shorten Notice”) [Docket No. 1053].

4. Thereafter, on February 18, 2010, the Chapter 11 Trustee filed its *Notice of Withdrawal of Motion of Chapter 11 Trustee to Shorten Notice and Response to Trustee’s Motion for Order (I) Authorizing Debtors’ Estates to Obtain Postpetition Financing and to Grant Security Interests and Superpriority Administrative Expense Status Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 105, 363(c), 364(c), 364(e), and 507(b); (II) Modifying the Automatic Stay Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 362; and (III) Granting Other Relief* (the “Withdrawal Notice”) [Docket No. 1057] with this Court.

5. The Order to Shorten Notice should therefore be vacated.

6. The Chapter 11 Trustee respectfully requests that this Court enter an order vacating the Order to Shorten Notice, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, at the earliest convenience of this Court.
