On Monday, the Court issued an Order granting-in-part and denying-in-part third party Rovi's motion to seal to its license agreement with Apple. In the Order, Judge Koh states that "should Rovi or Apple believe that the effect of this Order must be stayed pending the appeal with the Federal Circuit, Rovi and/or Apple must file a formal request for a stay of the effects of this Order within seven (7) days."
