**[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING  
APPLE INC.'S UNOPPOSED MOTION  
TO STAY JULY 29, 2013 ORDER (DKT.  
2350)**

24 Apple has filed an Unopposed Motion to Stay this Court's July 29 Order Granting Third  
25 Party Rovi's Limited Motion to Intervene and Granting-in-Part and Denying-in-Part Motion to  
26 Seal (Dkt. 2350). Apple requests the Court stay its Order pending resolution of Apple's pending  
27 appeal of sealing issues to the Federal Circuit. As the Court has previously held, once  
28 information is publicly filed, what once may have been trade secret no longer will be. Thus,  
Apple may be irreparably injured absent a stay. In contrast, the public interest, which favors  
disclosure of relevant information in order to understand the proceedings, is not unduly harmed

1 by a short stay.

2 Accordingly, Apple's motion to stay is GRANTED.
